

The importance of home. CASE STUDY


- Sidney Myer Haven A Haven Home Safe affordable housing community
- 19, two-bedroom units
- SMH has supported 74 adults and 39 children through the Shared Futures program
- Individually tailored for each resident
- The program largely focuses on social and community building activities






Bendigo demographics.

- The percentage of lone person and single parent households is greater than the state average
- 20.91% receive Age Pension, Disability Support Pension or JobSeeker, which is higher than the national average of 16.19% exacerbating the impact of these housing pressures.
- A lower average income of \$56,542 in Bendigo compared to the national average \$65,953, making housing cost increases harder to sustain.







Housing in Bendigo.

RENTING

12 month median rental increase of:

- 8.1% for houses (\$400)
- 20.7% for units and apartments (\$350)
 Greater Bendigo vacancy rates are 0.67.


BUYING

- Median purchase price of a house \$670,000 (up 21.3% in 12 months)
- Median purchase price of a unit/apartment \$395,000 (down 3.8% in 12 months)

Regional Housing Challenges.


- Increase in people presenting in financial stress
- Last year we saw 1,580 first-time clients
- 1 in 4 families now seek food relief
- Over 3000 applicants on the waiting list for housing
- Big Housing Build by Homes Victoria will see more the 683 homes built across regional Victoria.





Who are HHS Supporting.

- Single people impacted by huge rental increases
- Single mothers on Centrelink, who are paying high rent and needing support with living expenses
- Women over 50 who are living in their car
