135 C BLUNT BOAT BUILDERS SITE Saturday 29 July 10am-4pm



The Blunt family business has been operating in the Williamstown area since the 1880s, producing finely built craft including 24 sailing vessels from a yard with shed, pier and slipway on the waterfront. The pressed steel fascia is one of the heritage-listed building's original features. Experience 170 years of possibly Australia's oldest boat building family still restoring and building timber vessels at their heritage-listed site.

The Former Morgue in Williamstown is a coursed bluestone structure built in 1859 near Gem Pier, where the overflow from the autopsies could be swept into the sea. Bodies were encased in hessian bags and hung out of reach of rats. The Seaworks Maritime museum will take guided tours on the former Williamstown Morgue. In 2023 the morgue will celebrate its 150th anniversary in its current location.

## **131 THE COTTON MILLS**

The Cotton Mills site was built in 1926 as an expansion of the Barnet Glass Rubber Company. Designed by the same architect as the former Footscray Town Hall, its dramatic brick chimney and densely-built red brick processing buildings are architecturally notable for their unified design on a massive scale representing the heights of early 20th-century industrial developments. Learn about the precinct's history and visit select businesses.

As the largest building of its kind in Melbourne's west, Williamstown Town Hall, built in 1927 by prolific architect Joseph Plottel. It is an important part of Williamstown's identity and represents the growth and development of the city over a long period. Take a self-guided tour of this original example of an interwar municipal complex that comprises municipal offices. council chambers and the town hall ballroom
